2022 Nominating Petition for Teacher Board Member

The 10-member NYSTRS Board includes three teacher members elected by delegates representing System members. Trustees serve without compensation and are responsible as fiduciaries to protect the long-term value of the System's investment portfolio in order to provide benefit security for members. One teacher member is elected each year and each serves a three-year term. This year, the following seat is up for election:

- **TEACHER BOARD MEMBER ELECTION:** Juliet C. Benaquisto, a teacher in the Schenectady City School District, is the incumbent running for election for the 2023-2026 term.

Use this form only if you wish to nominate a candidate to oppose the incumbent in the election. It is **NOT** necessary to use this form to nominate the incumbent for election as they are automatically on the ballot.

Only delegates (not alternates) may nominate a candidate for teacher trustee. Only candidates nominated by 100 or more delegates properly registered by their employers will be placed on the ballot. The deadline for submitting nominations is **Friday, Oct. 14, 2022**. The election will occur Monday, Nov. 7 at the Annual Meeting of NYSTRS Delegates, which will be held as a hybrid event.
