2023 Nominating Petition for Teacher Board Member Election

The 10-member NYSTRS Board includes three teacher members elected by delegates representing System members. Trustees serve without compensation and are responsible as fiduciaries to protect the long-term value of the System's investment portfolio in order to provide benefit security for members. One teacher member is elected each year and each serves a three-year term. The election is held at the System's Annual Delegates Meeting.

The seat up for election at the 2023 Delegates Meeting is for the term commencing Feb. 1, 2024 and ending Jan. 31, 2027. The incumbent running for election is Elizabeth A. Chetney, a teacher in the Baldwinsville Central School District.

Use this form only if you wish to nominate a candidate to oppose the incumbent in the election. It is **NOT** necessary to use this form to nominate the incumbent for election as they are automatically on the ballot.

Only delegates (not alternates) may nominate a candidate for teacher trustee. Only candidates nominated by 100 or more delegates properly registered by their employers will be placed on the ballot. The deadline for submitting nominations is **4 p.m. on Friday, Sep. 29, 2023**. The election will occur Monday, Nov. 6 at the Annual Meeting of NYSTRS Delegates.
